When do I need an Import Export License?

All importers and exporters in South Africa are required to register with customs at the South African Revenue Service (SARS) if you:

- Import or export more than R150,000 in one calendar year.
- Import or export more than three times in one calendar year.
- Import for resale or commercial purposes, not personal use.

Upon registration you will receive a Customs Client Number (CCN), which is required by Customs to clear your goods. If you don't have an import export license and have goods at customs, your goods may be seized and you may incur storage fees and penalties. You may also be liable to criminal prosecution.

What are the benefits to having an Import Export license?

Market access: An Import Export license can grant a business access to international markets for exporting goods, allowing your business to grow outside South African borders.

Ability to register under trade agreements: An import license allows you to register under any of the trade agreements South Africa has with partner countries, which help eliminates or lower import costs.



When do I need additional Import or Export Permits?

Companies or individuals wishing to import or export controlled goods, used goods, second-hand goods, waste or scrap into the country, need to obtain an ITAC Permit from International Trade Administration Commission (ITAC).
